



1. **Competition**

1.1 Depending on nominations, each division will host one team with the possibility to add a second side if the numbers are full.

1.1.1 Competition will commence on the date within the SCJRL Operations manual with Sign on to be done via My Sideline on the dates set by the committee at the AGM.

1.2 Starting times will be determined by SCJRL.

2. **Fees**

2.1 Seniors fees will be \$230 and will be reconsidered at the Annual General Meeting each year. Fees may include vouchers, Electronic EFT. Fees must be paid prior to taking field on first round of competition.

2.2 In exceptional circumstances where a player is signing on for the first half of the season only, that player will not be eligible to play in finals.

2.3 Fees may not be transferred from one player to another.

3. **Player Eligibility**

3.1 Players must be registered and insured prior to the first game.

3.2 **NO UNREGISTERED UNFINANCIAL PLAYERS MAY TAKE THE FIELD.**

4. Uniforms

4.1 Teams must wear uniforms provided by BIJRL.

5. Games

5.1 SCJRL Rules will apply according to the Operations Manual.

5.2 Each team may nominate a minimum of 6 players in the younger groups and a minimum of 14 players in the international grades.

5 Procedures for Finals Games

5.1 As per the SCJRL Operation Manual.

7 Meetings

7.1 Each bi-monthly meeting is a general committee meeting and will be open to any person who would like to attend.

7.2 The AGM will be held in October each year with the Finances audited and provided for the meeting. The AGM will be notified to the members and life members.

8.1 As per the SCJRL Operation Manual.

9 Referees Notes

9.1 The referee, will be supplied by BIJRL each week. Referees will be paid through Direct Transfer at the fee set by SCJRL.

10 Disciplinary

10.1 The Disciplinary Manual which can be viewed at www.qrl.com.au has been adopted by the Association.

10.2 Players requiring disciplinary sanctions will be completed by the SCJRL.

10.3 Please be aware that as a member, Parent, Player or spectator of the BIJRL, suspensions may be scrutinised by the BIJRL Committee internally.

10.4 The following are examples of penalties as recommended in the BIJRL Disciplinary Guidelines adopted in 2021.

10.5 BIJRL will adhere to the Disciplinary Process adopted in 2019.

11 Injury

11.1 In case of injury the referee must be notified and the injury and circumstances. Team FAO's will keep a record of the injury.

14.1 BIJRL will select team staff each year using the coaching criteria and nomination form. The personal will meet the required accreditation including blue cards to be considered.
